On Tuesday, June 8 at 11:00 a.m., downtown business CW Crafts will hold a ribbon cutting and grand re-opening ceremony. CW Crafts moved from their Main Street location to their new building, 114 Roper Street, which was formerly Habitat for Humanity. The new store will bring new opportunities for sewing veterans or those looking to learn.

“Because of an enlarging product line and customer enthusiasm over classes being offered, the decision was made to move to our present location at 114 Roper Street,” said Wesley Williams, co-owner. He says the new space provides a crafter’s showroom and more room to expand their fabric and yarn inventory. On the second floor, three classrooms will be available to teach knitting, crocheting, quilting, scrap booking and more by experienced instructors. A new “Crafter’s Lounge” is open upstairs, as well, for patrons to relax and catch up on sewing and knitting projects. One more addition is the indoor flea market. Vendors can buy a space for only \$10, and the flea market will run Saturdays from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. “We’re very thankful for the support we’ve received in the past, and look forward to serving the citizens of our community for many years to come,” Williams added.
